- Ability to determine game outcome.

**STANDARD 2 - PROGRESSIVE TABLE GAMES:**

Each progressive table game with a potential progressive jackpot of \$25,000 or more must be recorded and monitored by dedicated cameras that provide coverage of:

- Table surface – clearly identify table bank, configuration of wagers, card values, card suits and game outcome.
- An overall view of the entire table with sufficient clarity to identify patrons and dealer/s.
- A view of the progressive meter jackpot amount – for linked tables within a single property, only one meter must be covered and recorded.

**STANDARD 6 - CASINO CAGE AND VAULT:**

- Ability to identify chip values and amounts on fill/credit slips.
- Dedicated color cameras and monitors for all fill and credit windows.

**STANDARD 7 - COUNT ROOMS:**

Required surveillance coverage:

A clear view of entire count rooms to include:

- Doors, entrances and exits.
- Safes and vaults.
- Drop boxes, and storage racks.
- Counting surfaces and personnel.
- Clear coverage of currency and coin.
- View scales and monetary values, and all hand count equipment.
- Ability to clearly monitor areas where currency is sorted/stacked/counted/verified and stored.
- Currency counting machines/equipment to include view of input/output/reject areas.
- Dedicated camera for all counting tables/surfaces.

**STANDARD 9 - RECORDS:**

- There are procedures to identify and store all video recordings.
- There is a seven day retention on all required video recordings for gaming areas.
- There is a 30-day retention on all detention room audio and video recordings.
- A malfunction and repair log has been established and maintained for a minimum of one year after the last date recorded in it.

**STANDARD 10 - COVERAGE GAMING SALONS:**

Required surveillance coverage:

- Table games monitored by dedicated cameras with coverage of:
  - Table surface, identifiable card values and suits.
  - Overall view of table with clarity to identify patrons and dealers.
  - Separate dedicated camera to view the playing surface, the chip tray, the number and denominations of all chips/lammers and all chips and currency deposited into the drop box.
- Dedicated coverage of all salon areas with the exception of restrooms.
- Dedicated coverage of all storage areas for all lammers, credit instruments, rim cards, chips, tokens or other representatives of value.
- All surveillance coverage must be recorded when the salon is open for play.
- All salon recordings must be maintained for at least 45 days with a primary and back up copy stored on board approved media.
- All salon surveillance must allow for 24 hour, seven day a week remote viewing from Gaming Control Board offices, in real time at a minimum of 30 frames per second.
- Remotely viewed PTZ cameras must be dedicated for exclusive operation by the Board. All hardware and software to facilitate the remote viewing must be Board approved.
- Slot machines monitored at all times with resolution to identify reel strip symbols, card values and all other indications of game outcome or malfunction.

**STANDARD 11 - CLUB VENUES:**

Required surveillance coverage:

- During hours of operation each club venue located on the premises of a non-restricted gaming establishment must record the following areas within the club by providing clear, dedicated coverage of:
  - Club venue ingress/egress.
  - Designated security podiums.
  - Bars.
  - Public restroom doors/entryways.
  - Entrances to all restricted areas.
  - Security office or other designated detention room where persons may be detained.
- General overviews of guest and employee activities throughout the club to include dance floors, walkways and seating areas.
- The surveillance system must monitor and record in both audio and video, the area of any security office or other designated detention room where persons may be detained by security personnel.
- A notice must be posted in the security office or other designated detention room advising all persons that the area is under video and audio surveillance.
- The detention and any questioning must be recorded.

**STANDARD 12 - DIGITAL VIDEO RECORDING:**

The digital system is capable of the following:

- Recording and viewing 30 images per second.
- Recording and viewing in real time (date/time superimposed).
- Recording and viewing on full screen.
- Ability to produce a still photograph.
- The visual resolution provides sufficient clarity.
- Media player software to support independent viewing.
- Watermark verification software.
- The failure of any single component of the media storage will not result in the loss of data.
- Visual failure notification system.
- Audible failure notification system.
